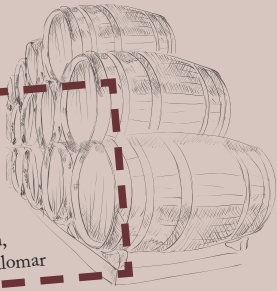

On the tasting menu: Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Meritage; \$10 for 6 tastes with logo glass

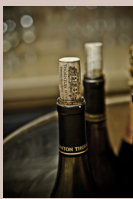
