Affiliate Membership Requirements

Section 3.2 Application, Qualifications and Rights

The Corporation shall have members as that term is defined in Section 5056 of the California Corporations Code. As provided in Section 7333 of the California Corporations Code, the Corporation may also refer to persons or entities associated with it as "members," even though those persons or entities are not voting members, but no such reference shall constitute anyone a member within the meaning of Section 5056 of the California Corporations Code.

(f). Affiliate Members: To qualify as an Affiliate Member, the Applicant shall be any business or individual not covered in the preceding categories of membership which the Board has determined pursuant to such Applicant's application, supports the objectives and mission of the Corporation and would otherwise be helpful in the advancement of the interests of the Corporation. Affiliate Members do not have a vote (i.e., are not Voting Members) and may not serve on the Board. Affiliate Members may attend TVWA sponsored or hosted social events. Affiliate Members may also attend technical meetings and seminars as determined by the Board on an individual case or event basis. Annual dues for Affiliate Members shall be recommended on an annual basis by the Board and shall be subject to approval by the Voting Members in accordance with the procedures set forth in these Bylaws for the casting of votes. There is no provisional membership or provisional period required to become an Affiliate Member.
