Associate Grower Membership Requirements

Section 3.2 Application, Qualifications & Rights

The Corporation shall have members as that term is defined in Section 5056 of the California Corporations Code. As provided in Section 7333 of the California Corporations Code, the Corporation may also refer to persons or entities associated with it as "members," even though those persons or entities are not voting members, but no such reference shall constitute anyone a member within the meaning of Section 5056 of the California Corporations Code.

(e). Associate Grower Member: To qualify as an Associate Grower Member, the Applicant shall own or lease a Vineyard located within the Region having, at all times, less than 3.50 planted acres of wine grapes. An Associate Grower Member may not vote (i.e., is not a Voting Member) and may not hold a position on the Board. Associate Grower Members are allowed access to general membership meetings of TVWA and seminars held by TVWA. Associate Grower Members are obligated to adhere to (i) all requirements attendant to its Associate Grower Member status, (ii) the Additional Standards of Membership adopted as part of these Amended and Restated Bylaws and attached as Addendum A to these Bylaws, (iii) the Code of Personal Business Conduct adopted as part of these Amended and Restated Bylaws and attached as Addendum B to these Bylaws (irrespective of whether or not such Associate Grower Member has signed the Code of Personal Business Conduct), and (iv) all other policies and codes applicable to members as the Board and/or the members, respectively and as applicable, may adopt from time to time. Annual dues for Associate Grower Members shall be recommended on an annual basis by the Board and shall be subject to approval by the Voting Members in accordance with the procedures set forth in these Bylaws for the casting of votes. There is no provisional membership or provisional period required to become an Associate Grower Member.
